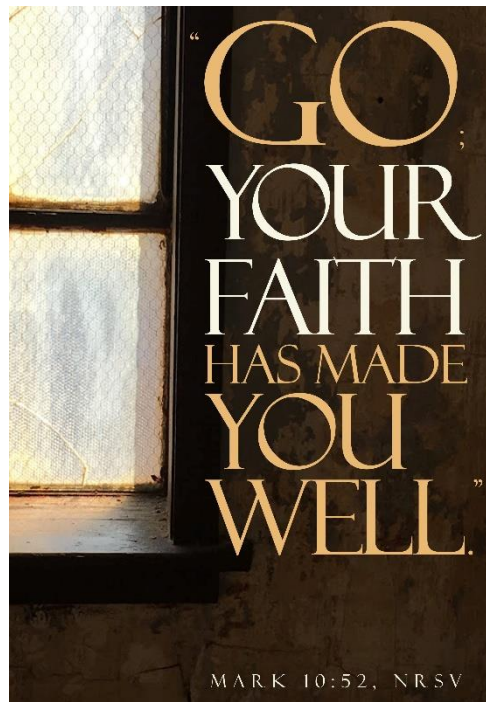

THE SERVANT MODEL

As we begin November, we celebrate the Solemnities (high feast days) of All Saints Day, November 1 (a holy day of obligation – masses will be celebrated at St. Thomas More Oratory at 12:30 PM and 6:30 PM), and All Souls Day, November 2 (not a holy day of obligation – mass will be celebrated at 12:30 PM). All Souls Day is a traditional day for us to remember all of those who have died, especially our loved ones and those often forgotten. Here at St. Thomas More Oratory, we invite you to write the name of any individuals who have died in our Remembrance book and they will be prayed for at mass every day throughout the month of November.

I also invite you to pray for them in your own way. Whether at Mass, in your daily prayers, or through the special way you pray, please be mindful of the souls who have gone before us. It is our true belief that the Communion of Saints, includes all children, women, and men, whose journey has gone beyond this experience on earth. As we readily pray for one another while we are here together, our commitment to life extends beyond this time here: “We live forever in Christ, and we remain in relationship forever. Our prayer is one sure way of maintaining relationship with those who have died.”

While our hearts call us to remember and pray for our loved ones, the gospel calls us to remember the poor in their death just as we were called to serve them in their life. I ask you to be especially mindful of those souls whose lives left them few people to remember them. These poor souls need us to remember them in prayer. As we are generous in serving the poor while they lived, let us be equally generous in praying for them now that they have died.

Prayers for All Souls

“Death has cotton feet on which it comes so quietly that we scarcely perceive it, and it takes us by surprise. But let us resolve to die, since it is something we must do, and with a peaceful, tranquil heart always keep ourselves in the same state in which we wish to be found at the hour of our death.” (St. Francis de Sales)

Into your hands, Father of mercies, we commend our brothers and sisters in the sure and certain hope that, together with all who have died in Christ, they will rise with him on the last day. Merciful God, turn toward us and listen to our prayers: open the gates of paradise to our brothers and sisters and help us who remain to comfort one another with assurances of faith, until we all meet in Christ. We ask this through Christ our Lord. Amen.
